We are writing to encourage you to invite the Quinnipiac University men's hockey team to the White House, in recognition of their recent NCAA Division I Frozen Four national championship win.

On April 8, 2023, the Quinnipiac Bobcats won a thrilling game in overtime to claim their first ever national championship. This spectacular win capped a historic season for the Bobcats, in which they recorded the most wins ever in program history at 34.

For almost three decades, Head Coach Rand Pecknold has built Quinnipiac hockey from a division two program into a true national powerhouse – appearing in eight of the last ten NCAA tournaments and in two previous championship games. The rise of Quinnipiac hockey mirrors the similar growth in academic excellence and prestige of Quinnipiac University, growing into a multi-campus, highly regarded higher education institution with national rankings in university quality, best colleges for veterans, and best educational value.

This win is the culmination of years of hard work and dedication from all the players, coaches, staff, fans, students and faculty of Quinnipiac University. 




