20	Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
21	of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture shall issue regula-
22	tions that clarify the quality and labeling standards that
23	food products donated under the Bill Emerson Good Sa-
24	maritan Food Donation Act (42 U.S.C. 1791) must meet
25	to be eligible for liability protection under that Act.
