## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Servicemember

5 Healthcare Freedom Act of 2025".

## 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

7 Congress finds the following:

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(1) Thousands of members of reserve compo-1 2 nents and the National Guard, in addition to their 3 military service, work for the United States Govern-4 ment in a civilian capacity. 5 (2) Nearly all members of the Selected Reserve 6 and the National Guard, and their families, are enti-7 tled to purchase a TRICARE Reserve Select (TRS) 8 healthcare plan as a service-related benefit. 9 (3) As of the day before the date of the enact-10 ment of this Act, eligibility for Federal Employee 11 Health Benefits (FEHB) prohibits members of the 12 Selected Reserve and National Guard from enrolling 13 in TRS plans. 14 (4) Removal of such prohibition for members of the Selected Reserve and the National Guard will 15 16 provide continuity of care throughout mobilization 17 cycles. 18 (5) Providing members of the Armed Forces

with the ability to purchase comprehensive, low-cost
health insurance increases the readiness and
lethality of the Armed Forces as a whole.

SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF EXPIRATION DATE TO ALLOW
 MEMBERS OF THE SELECTED RESERVE AND
 NATIONAL GUARD, ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL
 EMPLOYEE HEALTH BENEFITS, TO ENROLL
 INTO TRICARE RESERVE SELECT AS OF JAN UARY 1, 2026.
